ABOUT THE ROLE

Driver/Production Operatives are responsible for supporting Project Managers with the safe collection and delivery of build items to sites across the UK and supporting all production departments to ensure projects are prepared and loaded before leaving for show venues across the UK, Europe, and Worldwide.

Key Responsibilities:

- Completing vehicle checks, reporting any defects.
- Ensuring vehicle safety, maintenance and cleanliness.
- Driving to and from site locations across the UK to deliver/collect build items.
- Driving Company vehicles and plant as required.
- Safe loading and unloading of trucks.
- Preparing built items and road boxes for site.
- General support within the production departments which may include basic painting, sanding & filling and simple assembly work.
- Moving manufactured scenic parts between production departments requiring the use of manual handling skills.
- Completing housekeeping tasks and waste management duties within the workshop and external loading bays.

The above list of duties is not exhaustive and is subject to change. The post holder may be required to undertake other duties within the scope and grading of the post.
