ABOUT THE ROLE

The Senior Production Manager is responsible for managing the production teams, materials, and production facilities to high efficiency levels within the framework of all Company policies.

Key Responsibilities:

- Working with the Managing Director, overseeing the production planning process for production departments
- Material demand planning and stock control
- Sourcing suppliers, subcontractors and products as required
- Lead capacity planning activities ensuring delivery against operational requirements, optimising manufacturing efficiency and cost
- Prioritise projects based on deadlines, changing priorities as necessary
- Communicate project progress with key stakeholders highlighting any issues that may arise
- Lead and organise production meetings, chasing project details and communicating issues and progress status

Key Responsibilities:

- General people management of production supervisors
- Issuing and checking drawings as required, ensuring processes are followed and key information is signed off by relevant stakeholders
- Coordinate with the Design Team to ensure that key workshop personnel have the necessary input into design and specification
- Ensure that all Company and Statutory systems and procedures are followed with regards to the QMS
- Develop quality assurance processes within production
- Management and preparation of space ready for production and test builds
- Ensuring that all Company and Statutory systems and procedures are followed with regards to H&S
- Ensuring RAMS are obtained, reviewed and filed
